

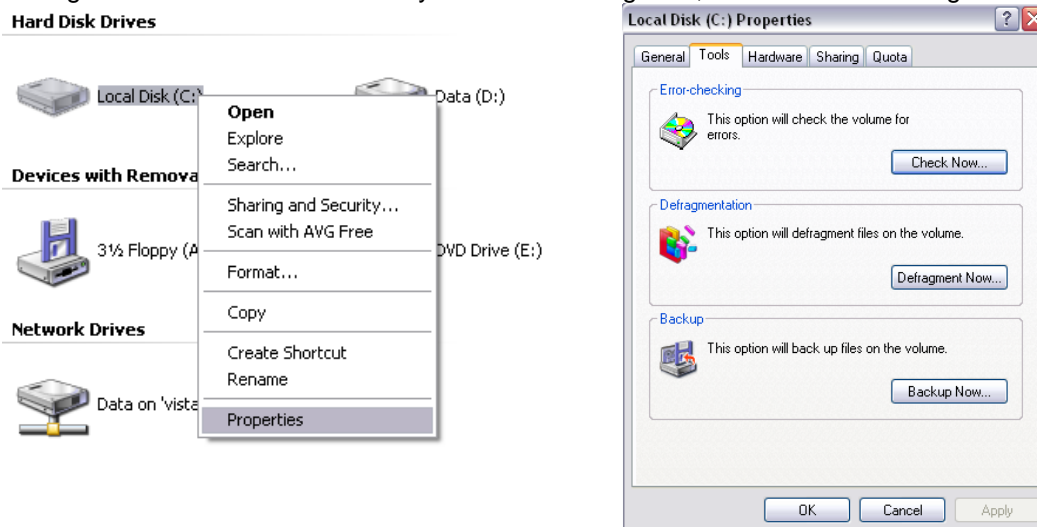
How to Defrag your Hard Drive: 3 methods, Most Users will use Method 1.

Notes: It's usually good practice to Run "[Disk Cleanup](#)" before Defrag. It'll help cut down on the amount of time it takes Defrag to complete.

Defrag **will not** happen if you have less than 15% Disk Space free. If this is your issue, [contact us](#) for assistance.

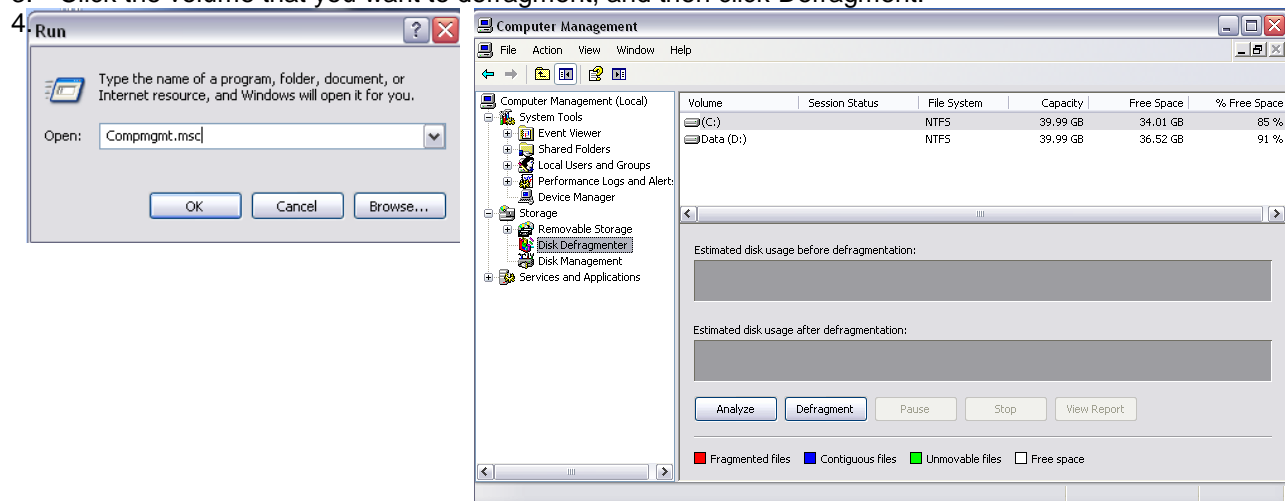
Method 1: Use the Properties of Your Local Disk

1. Open My Computer.
2. Right-click the local disk volume that you want to defragment, and then click Properties.
3. On the Tools tab, click Defragment Now.
4. Click Defragment. Click the volume that you want to defragment, and then click Defragment.



Method 2: Use Computer Management MMC

1. Start / Run; Computer Management MMC (Compmgmt.msc).
2. Click Disk Defragmenter.
3. Click the volume that you want to defragment, and then click Defragment.



Method 3: Use Disk Defragmenter MMC.

1. Start Disk Defragmenter MMC (Dfrg.msc).
2. Click the volume that you want to defragment, and then click Defragment.
